The City of Ocean Shores Water Department will be flushing fire hydrants in the south eastern areas of the City in October. Work will be conducted in the vicinity of Mt. Olympus Ave. and Quinault Ave. from Cape Alava St. SE to Cakesosta St. SE on October 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> and in the vicinity of Falls of Clyde Dr., Mt. Olympus Ave., Albion Ave., and Island Circle from Cakesosta St. SE to Discovery Ave. SE on October 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>. It is common for flushing activities to stir up sediment in the water lines surrounding the work areas. We recommend that you do not use hot water during the hours of 8 AM and 4 PM on the days shown above. If you experience discoloration of your water, please run the COLD water tap for a few minutes until it clears. If you must use hot water during flushing operations, we strongly recommend flushing your hot water tank after our operations are complete.
