
Construction begins on US 12 in Grays Harbor County next week

ABERDEEN –A busy section of <u>US 12 is getting a facelift</u> this summer. Starting as early as Monday, May 7, contractor crews working for the Washington State Department of Transportation will begin preparatory work to repave nearly 7 miles of state highway between Aberdeen and Central Park. Crews will also make repairs to the driving surface of the Wynoochee River Bridge.

What drivers can expect

- Nighttime, single lane closures during paving operations each weeknight from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. each following day. Work is weather dependent.
- Repairs to the Wynoochee River Bridge will occur mid-summer and require overnight, one-way alternating traffic.

This work kicks off one of two construction projects on US 12.
