CITY OF OCEAN SHORES 2019 Pavement Preservation Various Locations

August 1, 2019 – The City of Ocean Shores in conjunction with Rognlin’s Inc. will begin pavement preservation activities the week of August 5, 2019. Work will be conducted Monday through Friday, 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, and is planned to continue through mid-September.

22. SE Intersection of Ocean Shores Blvd NW and Pacific Blvd NW
23. Ocean Shores Boulevard: Ensign Ave NW to Sportsmen St SW
– crack sealing

Each location will be fully or partially closed to traffic with flaggers and/or traffic control devices to safely route traffic during the closures.

In general, the contractor will begin work with Location 1 and proceed down the list until the excavation work is complete. Once all of the excavation work is complete the contractor will return and cap the repairs with hot mix asphalt patches.

We appreciate your continued patience as we work to improve the City’s infrastructure. For your safety, please stay alert, watch for lane/channelization changes, and obey all construction signs and flagging personnel.
